








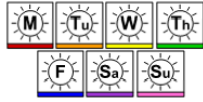
	<h2>How is the Vaccine given</h2>
 	<p>The <b>Vaccine</b> is given by <b>injection</b></p> <p>This is the <b>only way</b> to get the vaccine</p>
	<p>The <b>injection</b> is given in the <b>top</b> of your <b>arm</b></p>
	<p>You will need <b>2 injections</b> on <b>different days</b></p>
<p><b>1</b></p>    <p><b>x2</b></p>  	<h3>Injection 1</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This helps your body to learn to <b>fight</b> the <b>virus</b></li> <li>• The Vaccine does <b>not</b> start working <b>straight away</b></li> <li>• It will start working about <b>2 weeks after</b> the <b>injection</b></li> <li>• This means you still might get <b>very poorly</b> with Coronavirus</li> <li>• It will <b>not</b> last for a <b>long time</b></li> </ul>

## Injection 2

- Is given between **3 -12 weeks after** your first injection
- This gives your body **better help** to **fight** the **virus**
- It will **not stop** you from **catching Coronavirus**, but it will **stop** you from getting **very poorly**
