After your Vaccine you might	
	Have a <b>red mark</b> on your arm <b>where</b> you had the <b>Vaccine</b> This will <b>go</b> after a <b>few hours</b>
	<ul> <li>Your arm might feel</li> <li>A bit sore</li> <li>Ache</li> <li>Feel heavy or tired</li> <li>This will go after 1 or 2 days</li> </ul>
	Feel <b>sick</b> This will <b>go</b> after a <b>few hours</b>
	<ul> <li>You might get a temperature or feel like you have got a cold</li> <li>This will go after 1 or 2 days</li> </ul>
	Taking something like <b>paracetamol</b> might <b>help</b> you <b>feel a bit better</b>
	If you feel <b>poorly</b> or <b>worried</b> after your Vaccine you can <b>talk</b> to your <b>doctor</b>
