



ROSE Stands for.....

- R** Reach – Reach supports everyone working on the project
- O** Out – we are taking a message out to people
- S** Stop – we want to stop bad things happening
- E** Exploitation – when somebody uses somebody else badly to get what they want

The ROSE project enables people with learning disabilities to be heard and for their voice to genuinely influence work to reduce the risk of sexual exploitation at all levels. The work is funded by the Samworth Foundation Young Voices programme.

Fourteen Reach clients with learning disabilities are now trained as peer mentors. Following this training, they deliver sessions to teenagers with learning disabilities, adults with learning disabilities and health and social care professionals, raising awareness of sexual exploitation and the importance of staying safe when forming partner relationships.

The mentors work together, with support, to evaluate, devise and deliver the training on positive relationships and staying safe from sexual exploitation.



They are now prepared to deliver information sessions on this topic to family carers, to help them understand how to support their family member have safe relationships.

The session will cover the work of the Rose team, information on sexual exploitation and learning disabilities and suggestions for supporting a family member to stay safe and have positive relationships.

The content has been devised following a survey of family carer opinions carried out by the team.

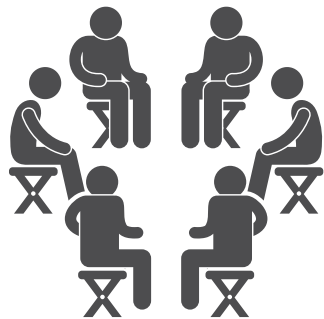
The session can be delivered online and we can put individuals into groups to take part.

We can also deliver to small groups of carers in a face to face setting.

We expect each session to last approximately one and a half hours.

Groups will have 6 - 8 participants.

The sessions will be delivered by mentors supported by staff from the Rose team
