£30,000 to go!

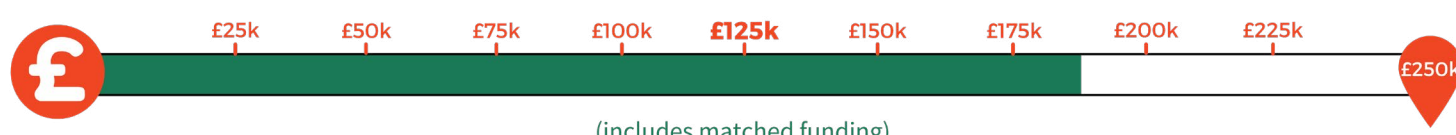
At Home in My Community Appeal

Don't forget that donations to our appeal are being matched by a local supporter right now - there is still £30,000 in the pot available for doubling.

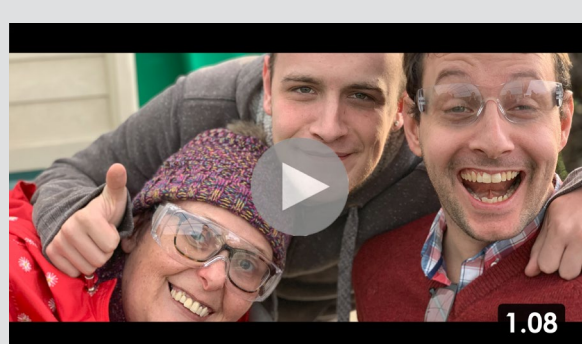
